


Day 1: Upon arrival at Queen Alia International Airport, you will be welcomed by our representative and assist you through the customs and immigration procedures. Then drive 45 minutes to Amman Hotel for Overnight.



Day 2: After breakfast you will leave the Hotel to Visit King Abdullah Mosque. It is a perfect sample of modern Islamic architecture; it has white marble walls and minarets with huge blue dome. The mosque was built by King Abdullah's grandson. The mosque was built in 1990, it can contain 7 000 prayers. In addition, in front of the mosque 3 000 men can pray. There is a small Islamic Museum in the mosque, after, a visit to the Citadel, Umavvad Palace, Jordan Archeological Museum JAM and the cave of the seven sleepers. Then transfer to the eastern part of Amman and visit the Citadel situated on the hill. You can enjoy the perfect views of the suburbs. Visit Al-Hussein Mosque in the Down town. It was built by king Abdullah in 1924 on the spot of an ancient mosque (640 AD). Then visit new King Hussein Mosque (west of Amman). A picturesque site and huge building win your heart. The mosque looks effective in the evening. Here there is a historical museum which contains unique documents relating to the history of Islam. After the visit you will back to Amman Hotel for Overnight.

Day 3: After breakfast you will leave the Hotel to Visit Jerash, Jerash is a mixture of the eastern and western culture. Everywhere there are signs of the ancient Greco-Roman Mediterranean culture and ancient Arabic traditions. Then transfer to the north of Jordan where you can observe two ecological and historical sites presented by nature and genius Arabic medieval military architecture -the forests of Ajloun and the Crusaders' castle in which the Crusaders were defeated 800 years ago. on the way to Umm Qais you will visit Alyarmouk Battle Site, Then you will continue to Um Qais, Site of the famous miracle of the Gadara Swine, Gadara known today as Um Qais was renowned in its time as a cultural center, It was the home of several classical poets and philosophers. Perched on a splendid hilltop overlooking the Jordan valley and the Sea of Galilee, Um Qais boasts an impressive colonnaded terrace and the ruins of two theatres. After the visit you will back to Amman Hotel for Overnight.



Day 4: After breakfast you will leave the Hotel to Visit Karak, An ancient Crusader castle, it is situated on a hilltop about 900 meters above sea level. Then Mutah Battle Site after that Transfer to Abdullah Ben Ravah's grave (in Al-Mazar), not far from Karak. Here you can observe also Jafar Ben Abi Talib's grave, the Prophet's cousin. He looked like the Prophet and assisted him on His way to Habasha and returned when Haibar was lebarated. When the Prophet saw him he kissed his forehead and said: "I do not know what is more pleasant to me – Jafar's return or khaibar's Opening". In Al-Mazar there is Zeid Ben Haris's grave, one of the first Muslims. Being a child, he was sold to be a slave. The Prophet bought him and released, then adopted the boy. Zeid headed the army. He died at the age of 55 in Hejree. After the visit you will go to visit Shobak Castle then you will be transferred to Petra Hotel for Overnight.

Day 5: After breakfast you will leave the Hotel to Visit Petra, It is one of the world's wonders. Walking along the streets one can see a lot of graves carved in the rocks, temples' facades. There is an ancient theater (sitting capacity is 3 000), huge monastery of Deir and Palacegrave. Then you will be transferred to Amman Hotel for Overnight.



Day 6: After breakfast you will leave the Hotel to Visit Tomb of Prophet Shuaib. The Prophet Shuaib (peace be upon him) more than one location and status in the land of Jordan blessed mqamh located 15 km southeast of the city of Salt 40 km from Amman in a valley called by his name, and the Bible talks about the name (Gethro) and priest owes and Moses' father, and Shoaib bin Mikel bin Ichger bin owe a children of Abraham and mother daughter Lut, peace be upon him. Then you will visit The Jordan Valley. Here you can observe Derar Ben Al-Azvar's (one of the Prophet's friends) and Amer Ben Abi Vakkas (the Prophet's relative) graves. Amer was one of the first Muslims. He knew the Koran by heart. He was said to be taken to Eden. Then, you will visit the Dead Sea Beach. Return to Amman. Then you will be transferred to Amman Hotel for Overnight

Day 7: After breakfast you will leave the Hotel and you will be transferred red to Amman International airport for departure.
